THEME 1- FIGHTING POVERTY (SDG 1-2)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

THE FIGHTING POVERTY MODULE WILL ALLOW YOUNG PEOPLE TO LEARN ABOUT AN IMPORTANT GLOBAL CHALLENGE. THE MODULE CONSISTS OF A ONE-DAY WORKSHOP ABOUT POVERTY ALLEVIATION AND TOURISM. IN THE WORKSHOPS, YOUNG PEOPLE WILL LEARN ABOUT THE DEFINITIONS OF POVERTY, THE LATEST GLOBAL STATISTICS ABOUT POVERTY, AND THE OPPORTUNITIES AND CHALLENGES OF PRO-POOR TOURISM. MOREOVER, PARTICIPANTS WILL TAKE PART IN THREE FUN GROUP ACTIVITIES: FIRST A DISCUSSION ABOUT BASIC LIVING STANDARDS, SECOND A POVERTY SIMULATION, AND THIRD A TOURISM PROJECT CASE STUDY ANALYSIS.

BESIDES, LEARNING ABOUT POVERTY, THIS MODULE WILL ALSO BE A GREAT CHANCE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE TO DEVELOP THE NECESSARY SKILLS TO BECOME FUTURE LEADERS. IN THE MODULE, BY ENGAGING IN VARIOUS ACTIVITIES DURING THE MODULE, YOUNG PEOPLE WILL BE DEVELOPING SOFT SKILLS SUCH AS COMMUNICATION, TEAMWORK, LEADERSHIP, PROBLEM-SOLVING AND CRITICAL THINKING. THEREFORE, THE FIGHTING POVERTY MODULE IS WELL SUITED TO EMPOWER AND ENABLE YOUTH LEADERS.

HAVING COMPLETED THIS MODULE AND POSSIBLE OTHER WORKSHOPS AND CAMPS IN THE PROGRAM, YOUNG PEOPLE MIGHT BE ABLE TO TURN SOME OF THEIR IDEAS RELATED TO PRO-POOR TOURISM INTO A LONGER-TERM PROJECT, WHICH WOULD PROVIDE LONG-LASTING BENEFITS TO THEIR LOCAL COMMUNITIES.
